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ACE / ARB stable dose letter

You recently had an appointment at the surgery to review your blood pressure and check your kidney function.

Following this we are pleased to inform you that your kidney function is normal and also your blood pressure has reduced to within the normal range. This means that your current dose of your ACE inhibitor (usually Ramipril) or your ARB medication (usually Losartan) — is the correct dose and does not need to be changed.

You do not need to do anything differently. Please continue to take the same dose of your medication as currently. You will be called for a routine review of your hypertension when it falls due.
